HEALTHCARE MISSION COMMUNITY HOSPITAL CLINIC

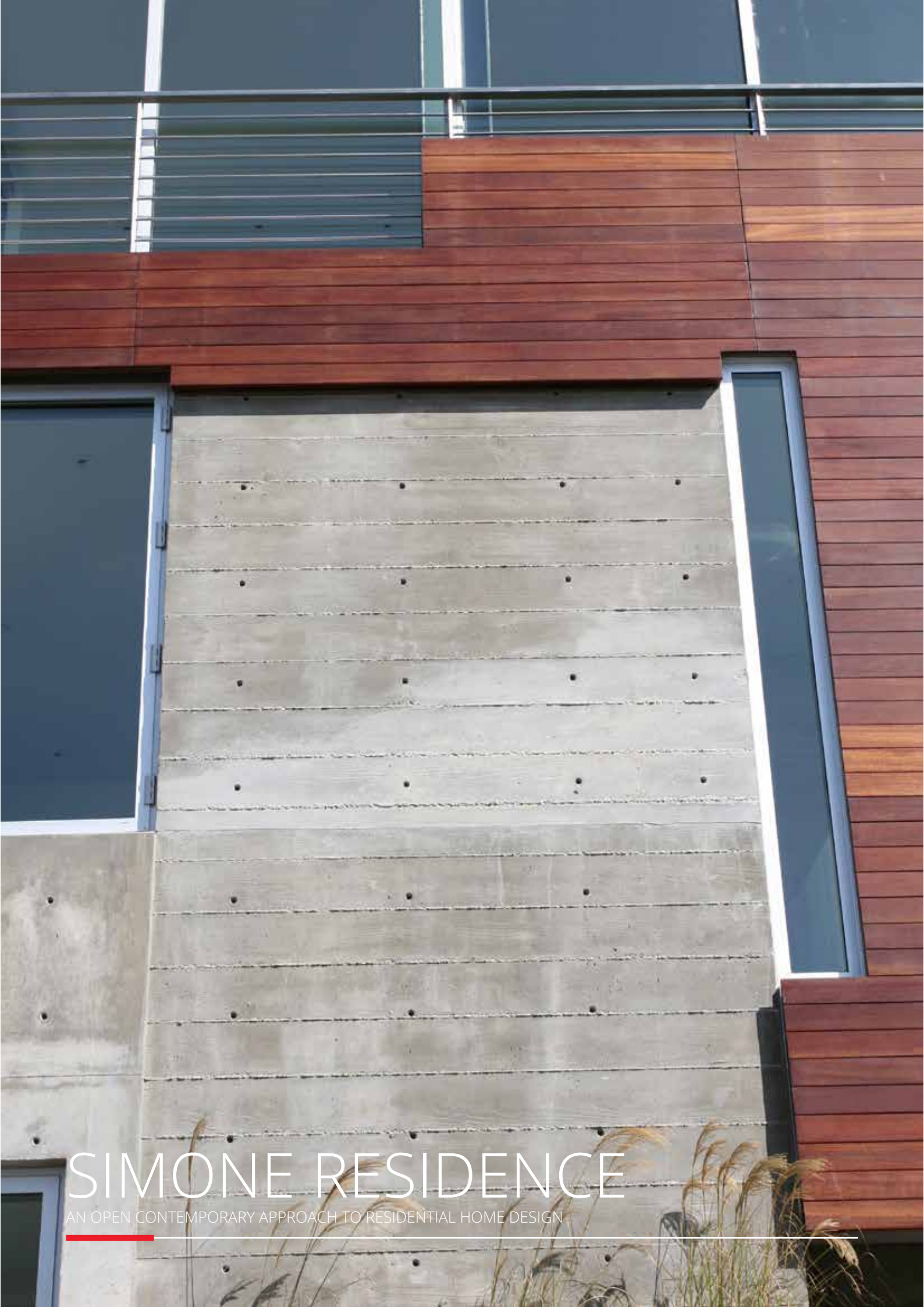
